Prior to college, Darren served as an infantry paratrooper in the 82nd Airborne Division, and was deployed into combat operations in Panama in support of Operations *Just Cause*. Darren was also deployed as a peacekeeper to Sinai, Egypt as a contingent of the Multinational Force and Observers (“MFO”), alongside other nations such as Italy, Fiji, France and the Netherlands.
