

As CPM Represents Class Members, Final Approval of \$77 Million Settlement Granted in SRAM Case

On June 30, 2011 the Hon. Claudia Wilken granted final approval to the last settlements in the *In re Static Random Access Memory Antitrust Litigation* case. The case was headed up by Steve Williams and Joseph Cotchett. The last two settlements – with Samsung and Cypress – bring the total recovery for class members to \$76,872,476.99 in this case which alleged a conspiracy to fix the price of static random access memory (SRAM), a critical component of computers, cell phones, and routers. The result was extraordinary given that the United States Department of Justice closed the investigation without any indictments or guilty pleas.
