

CPM Obtains Approximately \$39 Million in Settlements Regarding Transpacific Price Fixing of Tickets

CPM has reached several settlements in this case, totaling approximately \$39 million. This case, pending in the United States District Court in San Francisco, involves a global conspiracy to increase the price charged to people traveling by air between the United States and Asia. The 9th Circuit is holding a hearing on important issues concerning the power of the federal courts to adjudicate price-fixing conduct in the air transportation industry, which CPM will argue in 2017.
